### **Sizing and Measurements**

Vintage sizing and modern sizing is generally not comparable. We encourage all customers to know their exact measurements before ordering (you can find out by measuring your own clothes). Model Citizens provides detailed measurements of all vintage clothing to ensure that you, the customer, knows the correct size. We will note sizes if they are indicated on the garment but we encourage all of our customers to use the sizing charts.

As we have very slim mannequins and models, please note that many styles are pinned in the back. **Please note we do not accept returns for garments purchased that do not fit.** If you have any questions about our sizing/measurements, please write us at [chelsey@modelcitizens.ca](mailto:chelsey@modelcitizens.ca)

### **Measurement Guidelines**

All bust, waist, and hip measurements are taken straight across while garment is laid flat.

This is How We Measure:

Shoulders: Shoulder seam to shoulder seam

Bust: Armpit to armpit, and sometimes stretched for strapless or form-fitting pieces

Waist: Measured at the smallest part of the waist

Hip: Measured at the largest part of the hip, straight across

Sleeves: Shoulder seam to cuff. For dolman sleeves, measured from collar

Length: Top of garment, from shoulder seam to hem

Rise (for pants): Taken from crotch seam to top of garment

Inseam (for pants): Taken from crotch seam to ankle
